Please read these instructions carefully before you start to assemble this product.
Please carry out the steps in the order set out in these instructions.
Keep these instructions in a safe place for future reference.

» Care & Safety Advice

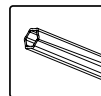
- Please follow the instructions as listed in this manual.
- Sort the parts and check against the contents list.
- For safety purposes we strongly recommend the product to be assembled by at least two people.
- Some parts have metal edges. Please be careful when handling components. Always wear gloves, shoes and safety goggles during assembly.
- Do not attempt to assemble the Gazebo in windy or wet conditions.
- Dispose of all plastic bags safely – keep them away from children's reach.
- Keep children away from the assembly area.
- Do not attempt to assemble the Gazebo if you are tired, have taken drugs, medications or alcohol, or if you are prone to dizzy spells.
- When using a stepladder or power tools, make sure that you are following the manufacturer's safety advice.
- Do not climb or stand on the roof.
- Heavy articles should not be leaned against the poles.
- Keep roof and gutters clean of snow, dirt & leaves.
- Heavy snow load on roof can damage the Gazebo making it unsafe to stand below or nearby.
- This product was designed and produced for it's aimed purpose only.

If color was scratched during assembly it can be fixed with the following tints:
Grey – RAL 7012

» Cleaning Instructions

In order to clean the Gazebo, use a mild detergent solution and rinse with cold clean water.
Do not use acetone, abrasive cleaners, or other special detergents to clean the panels.

» During Assembly

During assembly use a soft surface below the parts to avoid scratches and damages.



When encountering the information icon, please refer to the relevant assembly step for additional comments and assistance.

Step 8: Optional - if you wish to add curtains / mosquito netting - Please thread the plastic clips through the rail in each profile. (Curtains / mosquito netting are not supplied).

Add clips according to the specific quantity of curtain rings.

Step 10: It is recommended to use a carton or other soft material under the lowered corner in order to avoid scratches and peeling of paint.

Steps 10a+12a: Please note that screws insertion should be done from the outside.

Steps 11+13: Please note that screws insertion should be done from the bottom up. Afterwards please use the tool **T001**.

Step 14: Please add silicone on the inner area of part **#7661** as illustrated.

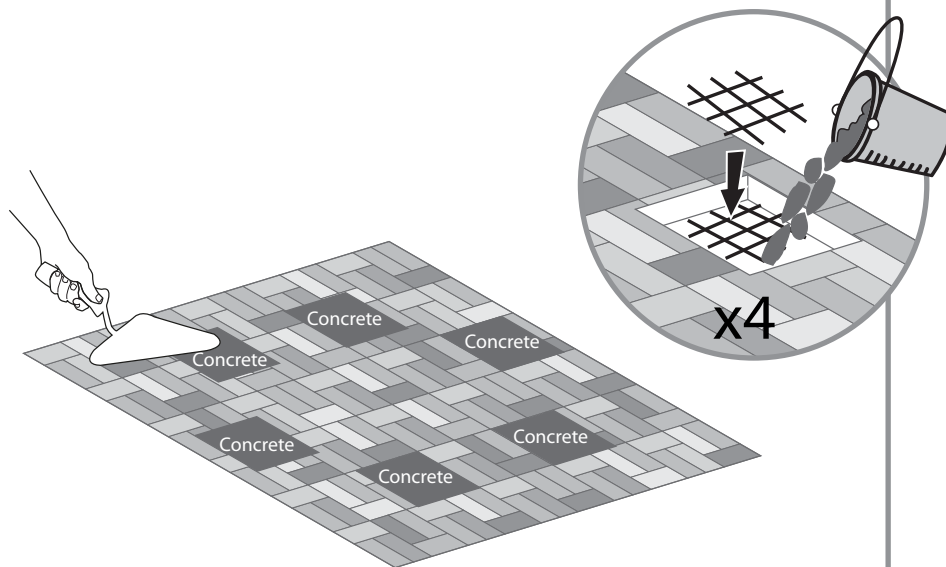
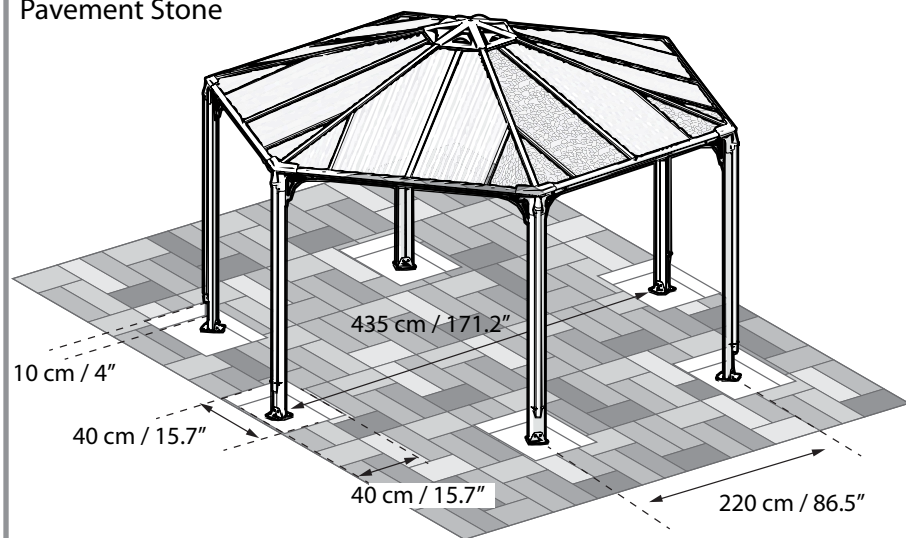
Step 19: Please drill holes in the panels, parallel to the holes in profiles **#7663**.

Step 20d: Press the drainage pipe into part **#8098** until it clicks and locks inside.

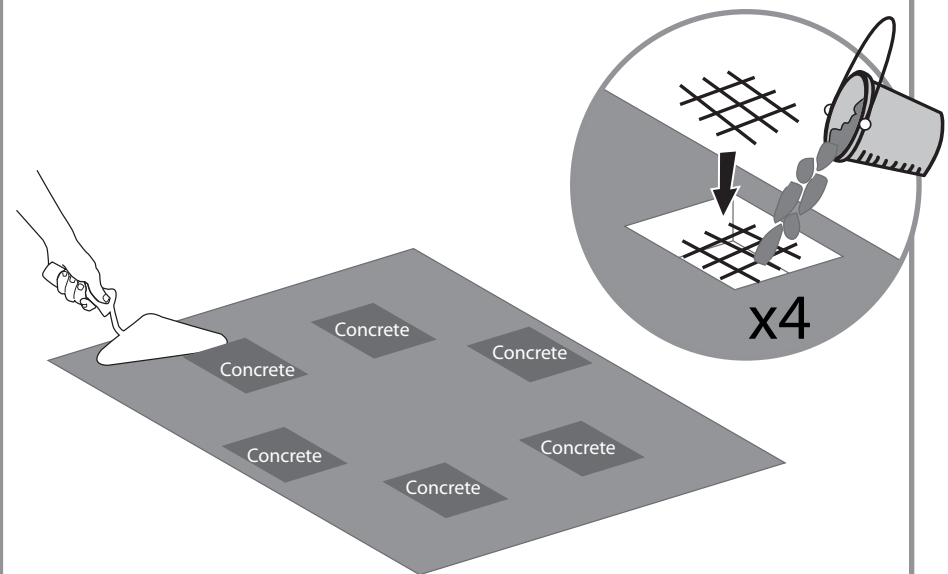
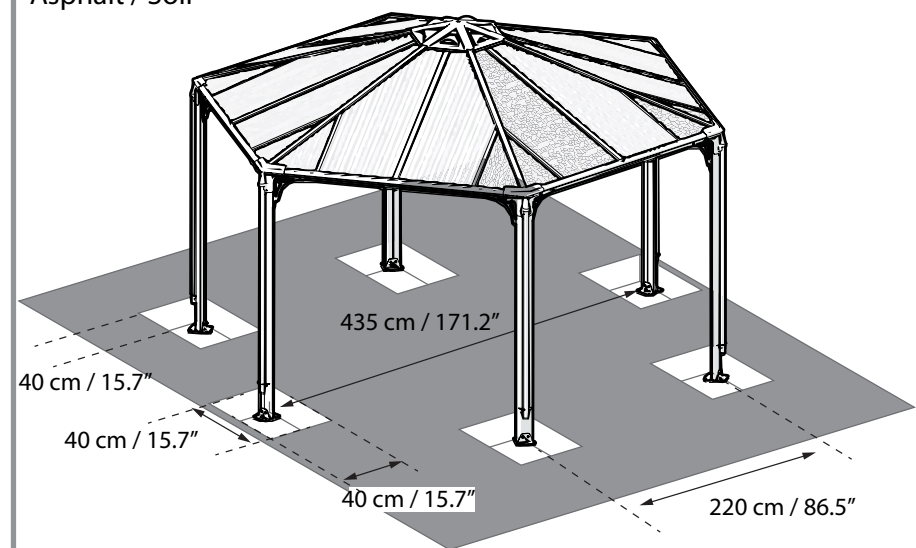
Step 21: Please level the profiles' legs and adapt screws and plugs to your specific ground type.

Please tighten all screws when completing assembly.

- Mantenga a los niños fuera de la zona de montaje.
- No intente montar la carpa si está cansado, ha tomado medicación, drogas o alcohol; o si es propenso a mareos.
- Cuando utilice la escalera o herramientas eléctricas, asegúrese de cumplir con las instrucciones de seguridad del fabricante.
- No se suba o permanezca sobre el techo.
- No apoye artículos pesados contra los postes.
- Mantenga el techos y los desagües sin nieve, suciedad y/u hojas.
- Una gran cantidad de nieve sobre el techo puede dañar la carpa y sería peligroso permanecer debajo o cerca.
- Es un producto diseñado y fabricado únicamente para el propósito para el que fue creado.

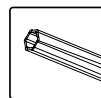
Si durante el montaje se rayara el color, se puede arreglar con los siguientes tintes:
Gris – RAL 7012

» Instrucciones de limpieza

Para poder limpiar la carpa, utilice una solución con un detergente suave y enjuáguela después con agua fría y limpia.

No utilice acetona, limpiadores abrasivos u otros detergentes especiales para limpiar los paneles.

» Herramientas y equipo

» Durante el montaje

Durante el montaje, ponga algo suave por debajo de las piezas, para evitar que se rayen o estropeen.



Cuando vea el icono de información, consulte el paso de montaje a que se refiera para obtener comentarios y ayuda en mayor detalle.

Paso 8: Opcional: si desea añadir cortinas / malla antimosquitos, inserte los clips de plástico en el rail en cada perfil. (Cortinas y malla antimosquitos no incluidos). Ponga clips según la cantidad específica de anillas de cortina que desee instalar.

Paso 10: Le recomendamos poner un cartón o una lámina de material blando bajo la esquina que toque el suelo para evitar arañazos o descascarillamiento de la pintura.

Pasos 10a+12a: Recuerde que los tornillos deben ser insertados desde fuera.

Pasos 11+13: Recuerde que los tornillos deben ser insertados de abajo arriba. Después, use la herramienta **T001**.

Paso 14: Ponga silicona en la parte interna de la pieza **#7661**, como se muestra.

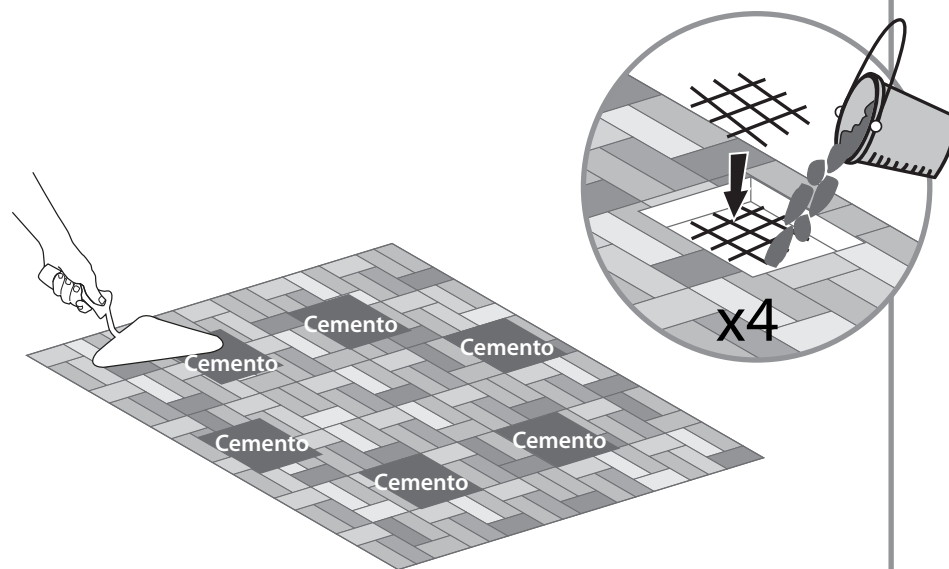
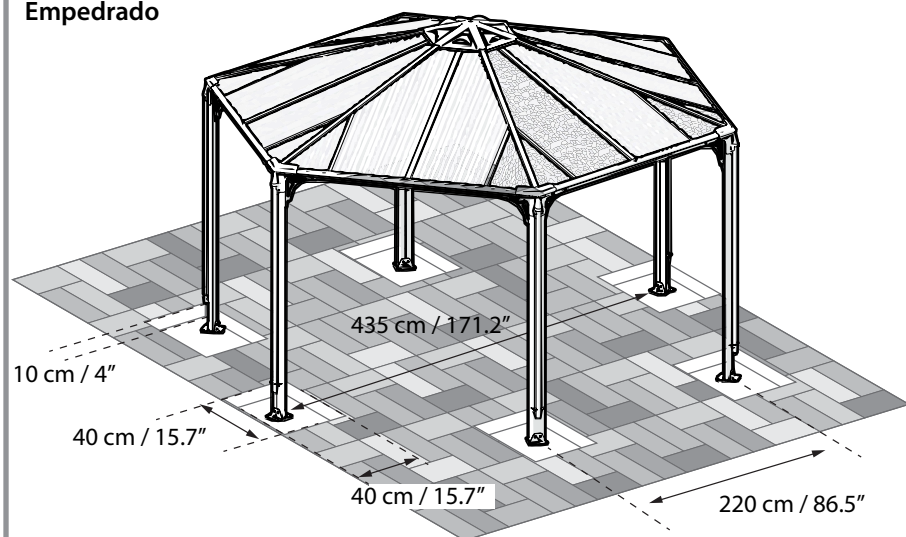
Paso 19: Perfore agujeros en los paneles paralelos a los agujeros en los perfiles **#7663**.

Paso 20d: Inserte la tubería de drenaje en la pieza **#8098** hasta que haga clic y se quede bloqueada dentro.

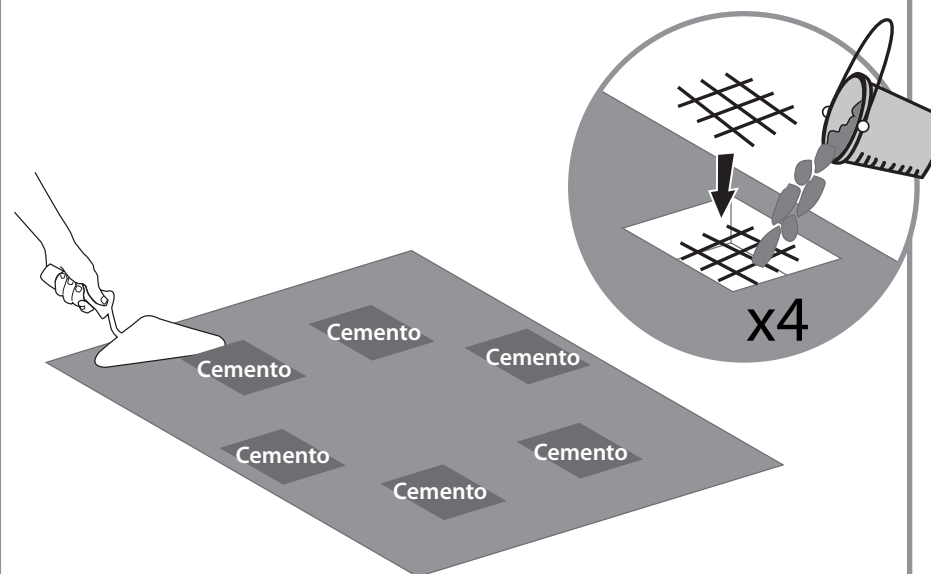
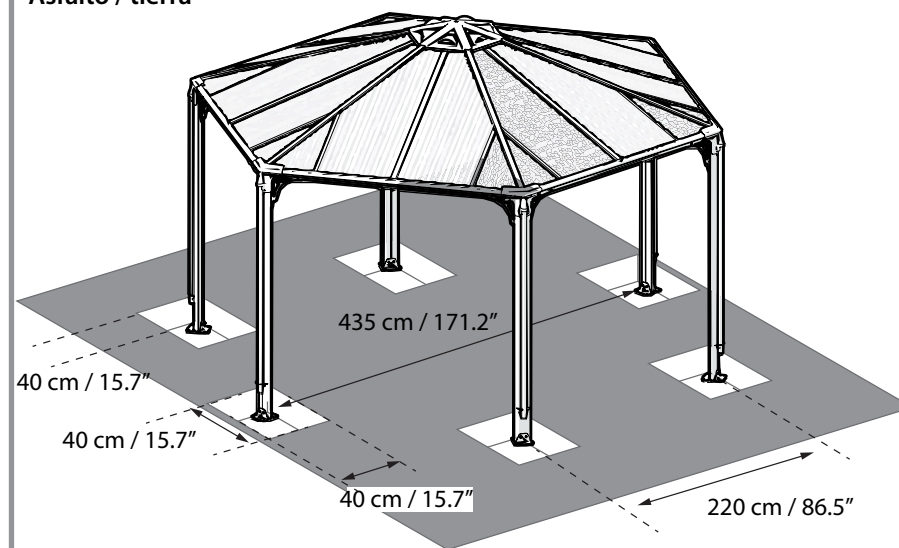
Paso 21: Baje las patas de los perfiles y adapte los tornillos y clavijas al tipo de suelo específico.
